

Training slots under the India Technical Economic Co-operation (ITEC) Scholarship Scheme of the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India for the year 2016-17 for training in India

The Government of India has announced the short term training courses for Sri Lanka during 2016 - 17 (1st April 2016 – 31 March 2017) under Indian Technical & Economic Co-operation (ITEC) and Colombo Plan in India.

The list of Institutes and courses available under this programme is attached in the ITEC brochure.

Training slots are allocated for capacity-building and training in diverse areas like IT, English language, management, rural development, finance, mass communication, remote sensing, etc

The Government of India provides following facilities to participants –

- Return air ticket from Colombo to training Institute in India
- Course fees
- Accommodation – Hostel / Hotel
- Living allowance of INR 25,000/- per month for meeting expenditure on food
- Medical expenses (only in case of medical emergency during their training in India)
- Book allowance INR 5,000/-
- Approved study tours (including places of historical importance)

Eligibility criteria for admission to Courses:

-Adequate work experience

-Academic qualifications as laid down by the Institute for the Course concerned (available in the ITEC brochure)

-Working knowledge of English required to follow the Course.

-Age between 25 to 45 years.

-Medically fit to undertake the training.

Application should reach the High Commission of India at least 3 months before the commencement of the course.

All members who wish to apply for the training courses are required to contact the WCIC secretariat for the application procedure.
